Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2010
In Compliance with HB 3693

The City of Nacogdoches purchases natural gas from Centerpoint Energy. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 33,345 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas.

The City of Nacogdoches purchases electricity from Direct Energy and Deep East Texas Electric Co-op. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 22,205,838 kilowatt hours of electricity.

The City of Nacogdoches is a self-supplier of water. In calendar year 2010, the City consumed a total of 46,743,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City of Nacogdoches in the calendar year 2010 is \$2,704,030.74
