NACOGDOCHES CITY COUNCIL

The purpose of a council meeting is to make and amend laws, develop policy, and make decisions for governing your city.

Regular meetings of the Nacogdoches City Council are held at 5:30 p.m. on the first and third Tuesday of each month, in the council chambers of City Hall, located at 202 East Pilar, unless otherwise designated. The council consists of four council members and a mayor. Council members are elected by ward and the mayor is elected at-large. After each election, the new council elects a mayor pro-tem who would preside at each meeting in the mayor's absence. In order to call a meeting to order and conduct city business, a quorum must be present. Three council members constitute a quorum of which one may be the mayor.

The agenda is the guideline for conducting city business. Items must be published on the agenda to be considered. The agenda is prepared in advance and items are reviewed by the city staff so the council will have all the pertinent facts and information. Copies of the agenda are available in the city secretary's office, on the city's web page www.ci.nacogdoches.tx.us and in the council chambers just prior to the meeting. Because there are so many matters for the council to consider during each meeting, the agenda is prepared in advance so each council member will have time to study each item. Any individual desiring a matter to be heard at a city council meeting should submit a written request to the mayor or city manager. Such requests should contain a short summary of the proposed presentation, and preferably submitted two weeks prior to the meeting.

Citizen participation during council meetings is desired and encouraged. Persons wishing to address the council on an agenda item must come forward when the mayor calls for public comment. Those recognized be allowed to speak for a maximum of three minutes and must speak only on the matter being considered. The person should come to the podium and state their name and address for the record. The council may question the speaker after he/she has finished speaking.
